Please note there will be no vehicular access on Bank Holiday Monday at any point.

Judging will commence sharply at 10.30am on the morning of the Mayfayre, therefore we will not be able to accept entries after 10am.

Entrants are not permitted in the Exhibition Hall until 11:30am. Presentation of the prizes will take place outside the main entrance of the Barn Theatre in the afternoon.

Competition Rules

1. Children must be the age of their class or under on Monday 7th May 2018.
2. Classes 5 and 7 must not be a kit.
3. Class 11 – The alien should be created by two or more members of the same family, with at least one child contributing to the finished alien.
4. Class 22/23 – The photograph must be mounted on card no bigger than A4. The overall winner will receive the Ifield Village Photography Trophy.
5. A Competition Entry form must accompany all entries; these will be available on the day or downloaded from the Ifield Mayfayre website.
6. All entries must be your own work; the judges' decisions are final
7. Unnamed entries will not be accepted. Please fix your name firmly to your exhibit where it **cannot** be seen by the judges.
8. All competition entries must be collected between 4 and 5pm on Monday 7th May from the Ifield Barn Arts Centre. After this time entries may be disposed of at the discretion of the Ifield Mayfayre Committee.
9. Trophies must be returned in April 2019.
10. Entry fees applicable. Children's entries are free, the family and adult classes are £1 per entry.
 - ❖ There will be rosettes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class.
 - ❖ The Family Cup will be awarded for the highest place family score over all classes. Double points are awarded for the alien category.
